Eugenio Barba is theatre director, writer, and founder of **Odin Teatret** (1964) and the Nordisk Teaterlaboratorium based in Holstebro, Denmark. These 56 years of Odin Teatret's laboratory resulted in the development of a professional and academic environment which is characterised by interdisciplinary pursuits and international collaborations. Since 1979 ISTA - International School of Theatre Anthropology- has been a research field, evolving into a village for artists, where performers and dancers meet with academics to compare and study the technical basis of their theatrical presence¹.

"Where can performers find out how to construct the material bases in art? This is the question which theatre anthropology attempts to answer. [...] Theatre anthropology is thus the study of human beings' socio-cultural and physiological behaviour in a performance situation."
